## 10. System of Play:

#### 10.1 Team Events:

- ❖ The format for teams events will be that currently used for World Championships with a team consisting of 3 players. The order of play will be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y, B v X. Teams comprising 2 players will be permitted to compete.
- ❖ Before a team match the right to choose A, B, C or X, Y, Z shall be decided by lot and the captains shall name their teams to the umpire, assigning a letter to each player.
- ❖ A team match shall end when one team has won a majority of the possible individual matches.
- ❖ In the preliminary stage of all team events, teams will be divided into groups of three (3), four (4) or five (5) teams per group according to the number of entries. The first two teams of each group will advance to the knock-out stage.
- ❖ The Team matches will be played best of 5 games, and according to the ITTF rules.
- ❖ In the preliminary groups stage there will be an effort so that teams from the same country will not be drawn into the same group; they will be placed into the next available group.
- ❖ Each team shall have a uniform appearance.
- ❖ Each country may nominate maximum 2 teams.

#### 10.2 Individual Events:

- ❖ In the preliminary stage of all events, players will be divided into groups of three (3), four (4) or five (5) players per group according to the number of entries, with the first two players advancing to the knock-out stage.
- ❖ Groups matches will be played best of 5, knock-out matches will be played best of 7 games, and according to the ITTF rules.
- ❖ In the preliminary groups stage there will be an effort so that players from the same country will not be drawn into the same group; they will be placed into the next available group.

#### 10.3 Double Events:

- ❖ Each pair shall have a uniform appearance.
- ❖ There will be only a knock-out stage.
- ❖ All matches will be played best of 5 games, and according to the ITTF rules.

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## 11. Eligibility:

Participation in the Hungarian Deaf Table Tennis Open is restricted to players who are:

- Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 dB in the better ear (3-tone frequency avarage at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, ISO 1964 Standard).
- If requested players must show their audiogram to the referee.

The championship is open to any players, not only to member of national teams.

# 12. Clothing:

All participants and officials must wear clothing, which is in conformity with the ITTF Regulations. Participats must observe the regulations contained in the Deaflimpics Regulations regarding advertising on clothing, etc., in the Stadium areas.

## 13. Hearing Aids:

The use of hearing aids or external cochlear implant is strictly forbidden during the competition.

## 14. Equipment:

### **15. Prize:**

Each winner and medallist will get a trophy.

## **16. Notes:**

- ❖ ITTF rules will be implemented during the tournament.
- ❖ As far as the equipment of the players is concerned (rubbers, blades, glue etc) ITTF rules will be in effect.
- ❖ Each player will participate in the tournament under his/her own responsibility as far as his/her health is concerned.
- ❖ Medical Aid will be available during the competition.
- ❖ Bottle water will be provided to the participants during the competition.
